NOTICE OF CONSULTATION



CONCERNING CROSSHILLS, LITTLE SMEATON

The Parish Council was offered some funding from National Highways to undertake a project for the mutual benefit of village residents. This enabled us to erect a fence to protect and conserve the area known as Crosshills [where the beacon is].

The intention is to stop vehicles, such as quad bikes and caravans driving onto the land – which has been a problem in the past - hampering our wish to promote a wildlife area for the enjoyment of the whole community. Pedestrians are not impeded by this fence and can just walk around the right-hand end. There is also a gate which will be padlocked, but a key can be provided on application, to anyone needing vehicular access for a specific purpose.

As the land is also designated as common land, permission from the Secretary of State is needed & retrospective application is being made.

A letter will be delivered to every house in Little Smeaton.
